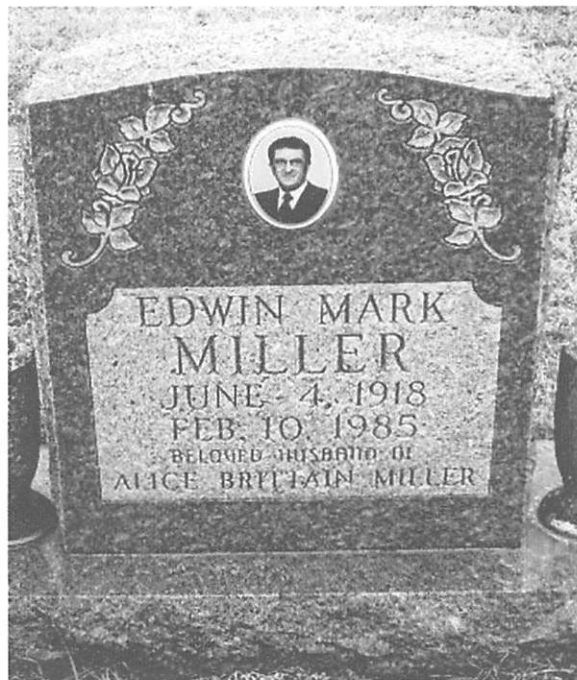

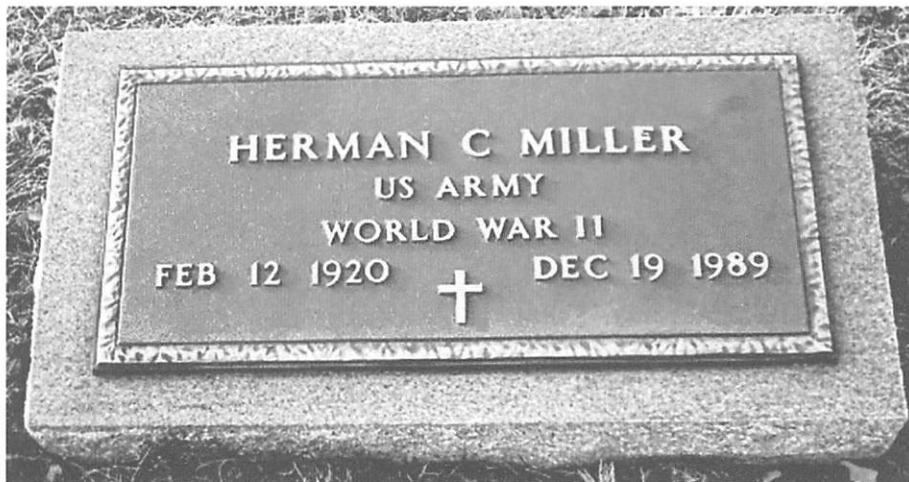

ONE DEAD, THREE IN HOSPITAL AS RESULT OF ACCIDENT NEAR HODGENVILLE CITY LIMITS

James Miller, 16, died at 8:15 p.m., Monday at the Kentucky Baptist Hospital in Louisville from injuries received last Thursday morning when an automobile in which he and five others were riding overturned on a curve about one-half mile East of the Hodgenville city limits on Highway 31-E. Miller, a son of Mrs. Lillie Miller, this city, never regained consciousness. The automobile, owned by Miss Sissie Milby, of near White City, was driven by Otis Crady, Hodgenville City Policeman, who was taken to Norton Infirmary in Louisville. He suffered a skull fracture and for several days remained unconscious, but for the past several days his condition is considered improved. Two others in the car, Harold Cruse and Bill Puryear, are at the Baptist Hospital; Cruse suffering a back injury and Puryear with both knee caps fractured. Crady, Miller, Cruse and Puryear were all reported to have been thrown from the automobile as it overturned. David and Russell Cruse, brothers of Harold, escaped with minor injuries. All were brought to the offices of Dr. Handley and Dr. Bradbury here for treatment. Besides his mother, Miller is survived by 2 sisters, Miss Joyce Jean Miller, of this city, and Mrs. Norma Reynolds, of near town; 2 brothers, Herman E. and Robert Miller, both members of the armed forces and several half-brothers.
