Mrs. Matilda Wathen died last Friday night at the home of her daughter, Mrs. James Milby, from the effects of a stroke of paralysis with which she was stricken last Tuesday morning. Mrs. Wathen was the widow of Mr. Tom Wathen who preceded her to the grave several years ago. She was 84 years old. The deceased was the mother of 12 children, 2 of whom died in infancy, the remaining 10 all lived to be grown and married. Besides her daughter, Mrs. Milby, with whom she had made her home for years, 7 children mourn the loss of a mother. They are Mrs. Alice Dyer of Missouri, Mrs. Hill of Kansas, John and George of Louisville, Tom of New Mexico, Marten of this county, and ?? Wathen. The remains were laid to rest at South Fork Saturday afternoon. The deceased had been a member of South Fork Church for several years. The children and other relatives have the sympathy of the entire community but should be comforted by the thought that their mother is at rest.

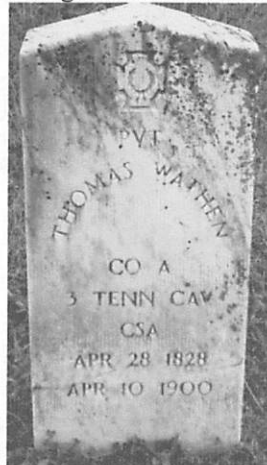

Mr. Thomas Wathen, son of "old uncle" Joseph Wathen, was born in LaRue County, April 28, 1828. There were 4 brothers and 1 sister; John, Benjamin, Martin, Joseph and Mary. Mr. Wathen was united in wedlock to Matilda Beauchamp in September, 1851 to which union were born J. W. Wathen, of Hart County; Mrs. John Esabel, John B. Wathen, Charles Wathen, Fannie Wathen, of Louisville; Mrs. Robert Hill of Kansas; Mrs. W. J. Dyer, Mrs. Jas. Milby and Martin Wathen, of LaRue County, and George Wathen of Edmonson County, besides 2 others who died in infancy, making in all 12 children. In addition to the 12 children Mr. Wathen had 42 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren. He professed faith in Christ and united with the South Fork Baptist Church early in manhood, living a consistent Christian life until his death, April 10, 1900, and giving every assurance of a blessed immortality beyond the skies. In his death the community lost a good neighbor, the church a faithful member, the county an enterprising and patriotic citizen and the home a kind and loving husband and father.

AGED CONFEDERATE SOLDIER FOUND DEAD IN HIS CHAIR

Ralph Petty Williams, 82, died suddenly at his home at Buffalo, last Saturday. He was born October 4, 1845, in Barren County, near Glasgow. In 1869 he married George Ann Armour, near Canmer. Three sons, Henry, Eugene and William; and 1 daughter, Mrs. Mary Moore, of Springfield, Illinois, survive him. One daughter died in infancy. He was one of 2 surviving Confederate soldiers of the county, the other being J. G. Terhune. He served gallantly under General John Hunt Morgan during the Civil War. About 50 years ago he joined the Reform Church in Barren County, later moving membership to Loama, Illinois. He was found dead sitting peacefully in his chair. Magistrate Roark conducted an inquest and pronounced death due to a heart attack. Burial was in South Fork Cemetery by the side of his wife. Thus passed a quiet, good citizen of long and honored life and vanishes one more of the thin gray line which was once the pomp and pride of the south.
