She said to them that were present a short while before she died that her prospects of Heaven were very bright and that she was only waiting for the summons to call her home. She leaves 2 brothers and 2 sisters, Wat Walters, Fielden Walters and Mrs. James Cruse of Upton and Mrs. Allen Gardner of Parker's Grove. She was 82 years 4 months and 2 days old at the time of her death, a ripe old age.

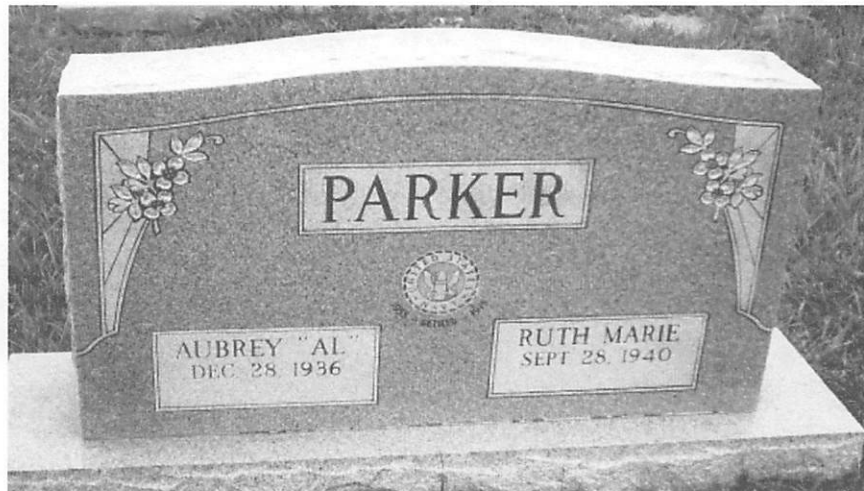

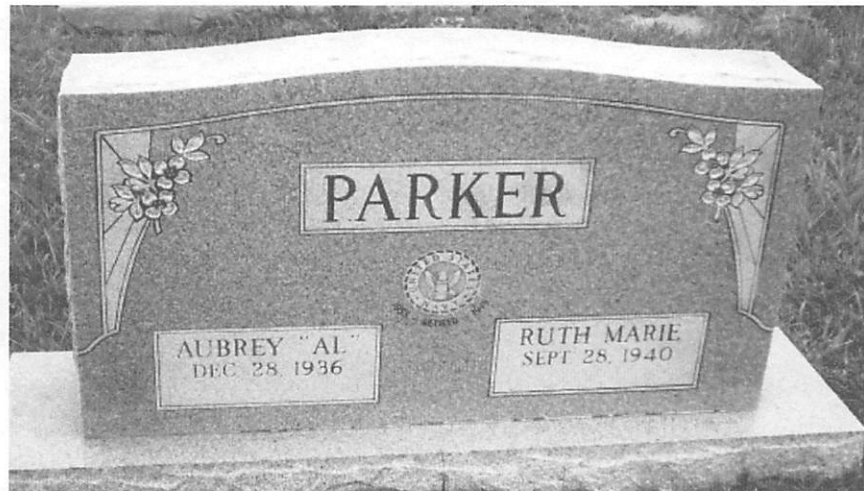

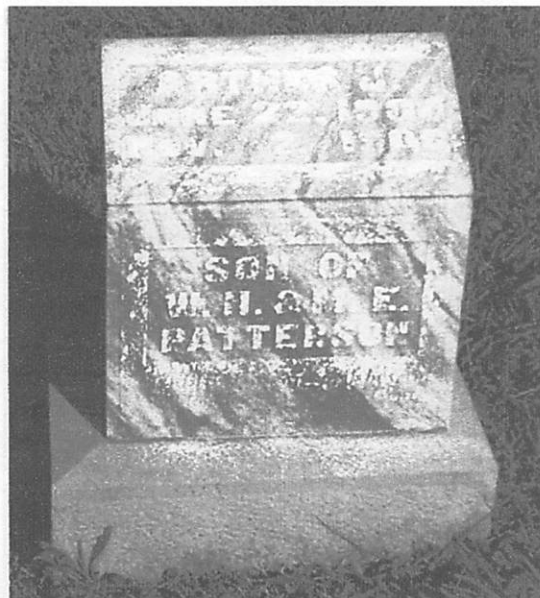

Death was due to the terrible and fatal disease, diphtheria. He was ill but one week. His remains were laid to rest in South Fork Cemetery the day after death claimed him, there to remain in the silent home of the dead beside little sister, Cora, and mother, who preceded him to the grave several years. These trials seem strange and hard to bear, but we know not the wisdom of Him who has decreed them. The grave is a dark and gruesome place, but the Saviour has slept in that narrow tomb. He too, has been among the dead. There is nothing in the grave to fear, for the spirit is not there. Little Arthur has gone to meet Cora and Mamma. So we would say to the sorrowing father to look for those loved ones beyond the grave.



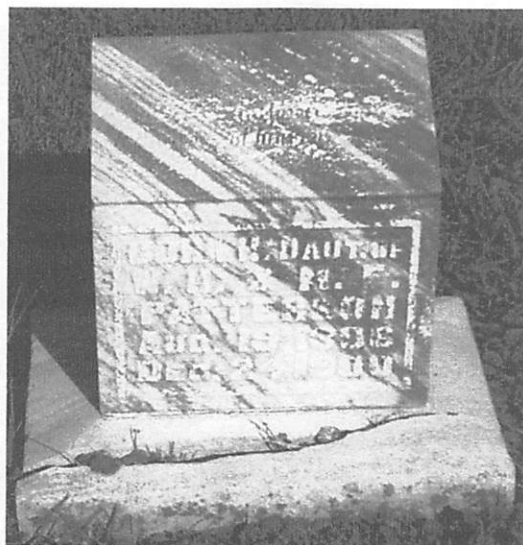

We received a few days ago from Mr. W. H. Patterson, of St. Louis, Missouri, the particulars of the death of his wife, Mrs. Mattie E. Patterson, who died at their home in that city April 25, 1905, the remains of whom were brought to this county for interment in the South Fork cemetery on April 27. The funeral services were conducted by Rev. L. R. Druien in the presence of a large audience and friends. Mrs. Patterson was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. T. W. Hill, highly respected citizens of the South Fork neighborhood. Mrs. Patterson was born March 8, 1873; confessed faith in Christ at the age of fifteen years in a meeting held by Revs. Pickett and Crouch at Orrenders School House, and she took membership with the South Fork congregation and was one among its most faithful members. The deceased was united in marriage to Mr. Patterson February 7, 1893. To this union were born four children, three of whom with the husband, survive the mother. Cora, the little four-year-old daughter, was called from earth to heaven several years previous. Though those precious lives, which were the joy and light of the earthly home, have been called away, they will shine brighter in the home beyond the stars and will ever be a beacon light to the bereft ones to bring heaven closer than ever before.
