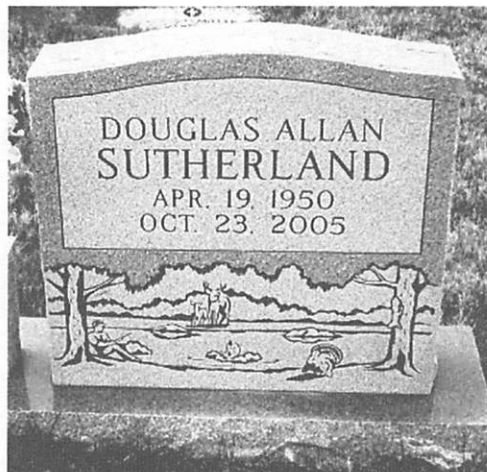

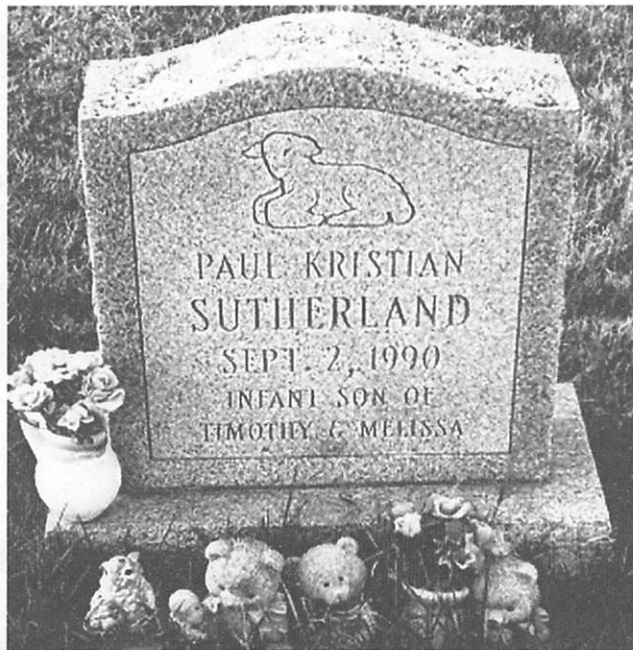

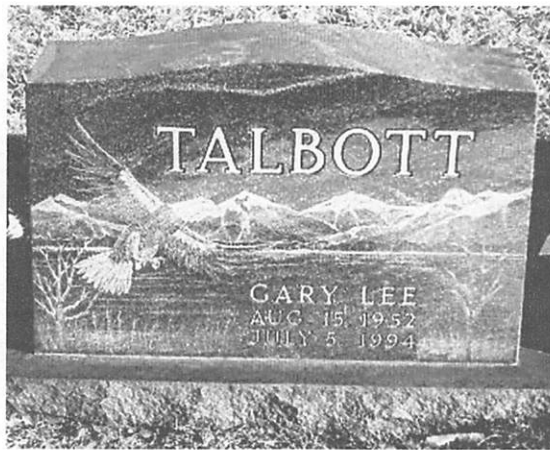

## TALBOTT DIED AFTER ACCIDENTAL SHOOTING

A Radcliff man's death on Gene Snyder Freeway in Jefferson County has been attributed to an accidental shooting, although the findings are preliminary. Police say witnesses saw Gary Talbott, 41, a Fort Knox employee and union vice president, driving a 1994 Chevrolet Corvette eastbound and passing several vehicles Tuesday. Witnesses then saw his car cross back into the right-hand lane, leave the pavement, travel about 700 feet and stop in a grassy area. Witnesses who had seen the car leave the road found Talbott's body. The Jefferson County deputy coroner said an autopsy was performed and that preliminary results led him to believe Talbott's wounds were self-inflicted and accidental. Talbott worked as a heavy equipment maintenance specialist for the Department of Logistics at Fort Knox and also served as civil service vice president of the American Federation of Government Employees Local 2032.

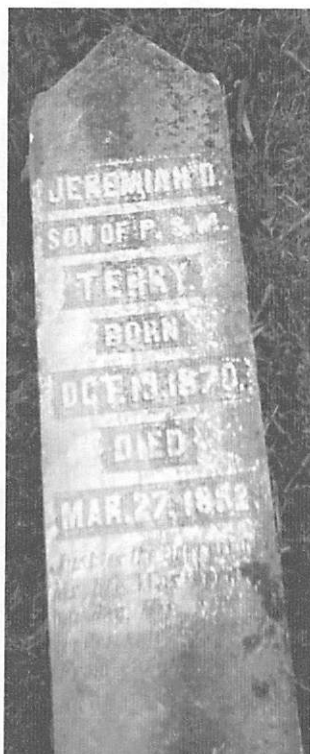

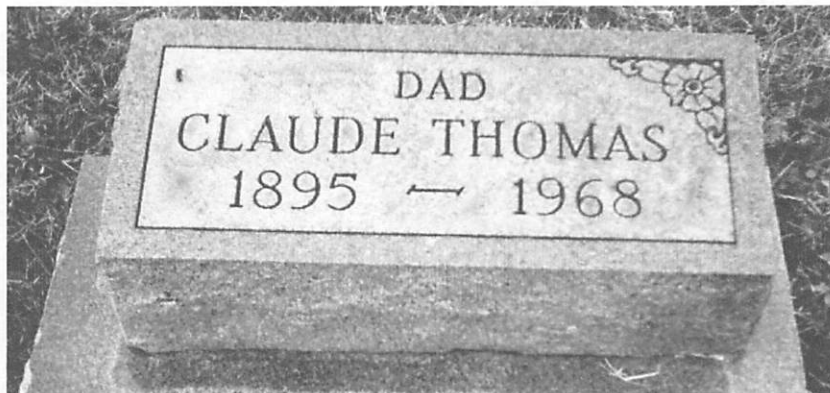

Miss Lizzie (Elizabeth) M. Thomas, of Lincoln Springs, died at the home of her nephew, Mr. John B. Durham, on last Saturday (8th) afternoon, after an illness of about 9 weeks. Miss Thomas was on a visit to her sister, Mrs. Mary Hill, and Mr. & Mrs. Durham when her illness set up and she was not able at any time to be removed to her home. She was at first attacked with lagrip, which developed into typhoid fever, from the effects of which she died. The deceased was born March 17, 1833; hence was 66 years, 3 months and 8 days old at her death. Miss Thomas confessed the Savior at about the age of 17 years, at a meeting conducted by Revs. J. P. Bryant and John Duncan at Mt. Tabor Church, the latter named minister being an uncle of the deceased. On Sunday, the day following her death, the remains were conveyed to South Fork Church, where a short funeral sermon was conducted by Rev. L. R. Durien. The body was then laid to rest in the cemetery at that place. This funeral scene was made doubly sad and impressive by the fact that another funeral procession moved into the church yard as the one moved out, the latter following the remains of Mrs. G. B. Orrender, who died suddenly at her home, near Mathers Mill, last Saturday. The oldest citizens of South Fork say they never witnessed a like scene at that place. The deceased, Miss Thomas, leaves surviving her, 3 sisters and 1 brother, namely; Mrs. Mary Hill, of Mt. Tabor; Mrs. Sarah Wright and Mrs. Letitia Arnett, of this place, and Mr. J. C. Thomas, of Lincoln Springs, all of whom have our condolence.

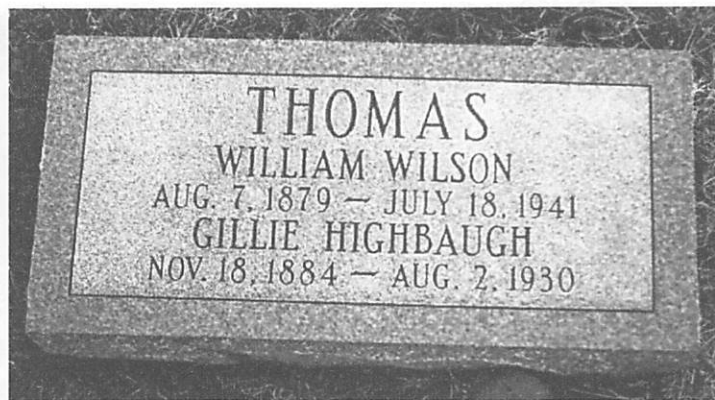

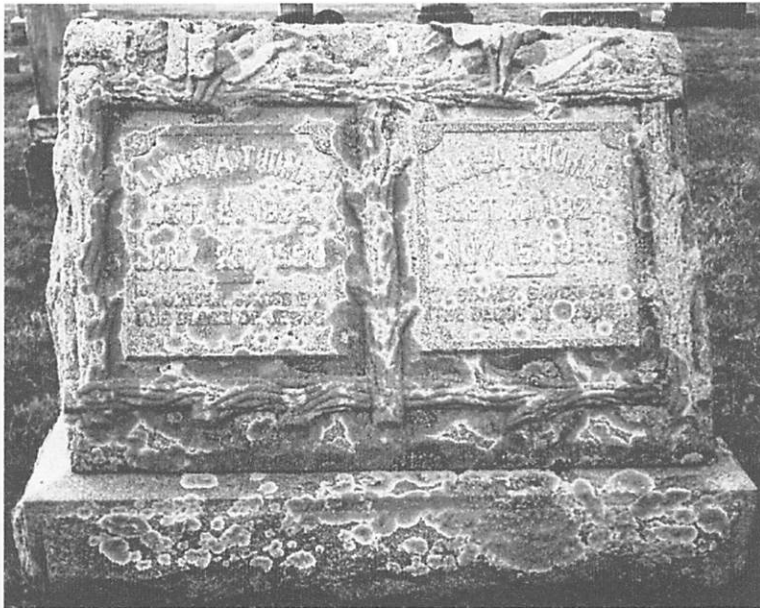

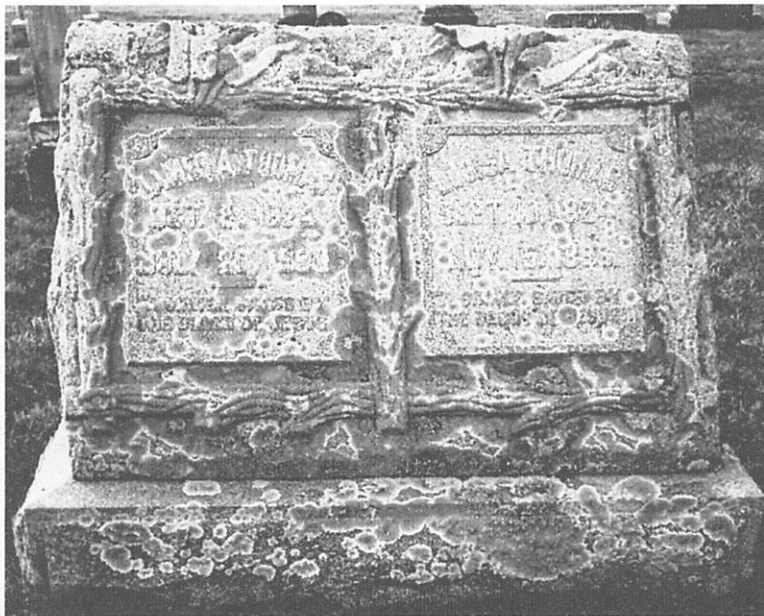
